#### Gideon Becomes Israel's Judge

<sup>1</sup> The Israelites did evil in the LORD's sight. So the LORD handed them over to the Midianites for seven years. <sup>2</sup> The Midianites were so cruel that the Israelites made hiding places for themselves in the mountains, caves, and strongholds. <sup>3</sup> Whenever the Israelites planted their crops, marauders from Midian, Amalek, and the people of the east would attack Israel, <sup>4</sup> camping in the land and destroying crops as far away as Gaza. They left the Israelites with nothing to eat, taking all the sheep, goats, cattle, and donkeys. <sup>5</sup> These enemy hordes, coming with their

livestock and tents, were as thick as locusts; they arrived on droves of camels too numerous to count. And they stayed until the land was stripped bare. 6So Israel was reduced to starvation by the Midianites. Then the Israelites cried out to the LORD for help.

7 When they cried out to the LORD because of Midian, 8 the LORD sent a prophet to the Israelites. He said, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: I brought you up out of slavery in Egypt. 9 I rescued you from the Egyptians and from all who oppressed you. I drove out your enemies and gave you their land. 10 I told you, 'I am the LORD your God. You must not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you now live.' But you have not listened to me."

- 4. How many years had the Israelites experienced peace?

- 6. Pastor Craig told us the lie people believe is as follows: I can reach across the fence, grab the thing (the secret sin) and bring it into God's peace, without disrupting the peace, and enjoy it. Why is this a lie?

One of the important things to note from this passage is that when the Lord handed the Israelites over to the Midianites it was a removal of His divine spiritual protection. He was giving them what they wanted and allowing the consequences of their actions. This was God stepping back and allowing them to experience the results of their choices. Because of the way this reads in English, many think God is punishing them, but it is not punishment. It is allowance of consequence and removal of protection.
