Series Thread: To live a God-honoring life in a culture that does not always honor God, we start with keeping our commitment.

Message Thread: "Now we will" (Daniel 2:48) – You face the impossible with the help of the Holy Spirit.

Daniel 2:11 NLT

· God can use high-risk situations to reveal Himself.

Daniel 2:12-14 NLT

• Daniel had wisdom and discretion in his tool chest; no one else did.

Action Item: When are you gathering wisdom and discretion?

Daniel 2:16 NLT

- Daniel went straight to the (unreasonable) source and made room for God to redeem the situation.
 - o Daniel 3:17 "Our God is able."

Action Item: Determine to respond with your faith ahead of time.

Daniel 2:17-18 NLT

- WHO do you RUN to for wisdom, faith, and friendship?
 - Do they believe "God is able...?" Or are they FAITHLESS?

Action Item: Identify who you will run to.

Daniel 2:36 NLT

- Pointed to God as his source.
 - Daniel humbled himself.
 - Have to admit my answers bow to YOURS.
 - Enabled Daniel to be led of the Holy Spirit.
 - o Not only that, the Holy Spirit empowers us for specific purpose.
 - o Acts 1:3-8 NLT
 - o Romans 8:5-14 NLT
 - Facing troubling times and impossible situations. Mark 13:11 NLT
- How does Daniel do this? It's an impossible situation.
 - o Daniel was being led of the Holy Spirit. He was not alone. "We will tell you."
 - He trusted God to make a way.
 - God led him each step of the way.
 - God gave him the words.
 - God gave him the heart to speak the words.
 - He was empowered FOR this moment.
- Had the presence of mind to recognize God had a heart for Nebuchadnezzar.

Action Item: Ask God to lead you by His Holy Spirit.

Daniel 2:48-49 NLT

- God used a high-risk situation to reward Daniel and give him more.
- Daniel, in 24 hours, went from unknown to extremely influential.
 - o He raised his shield of faith and it calmed him enough to:
 - Appeal.
 - Place his trust in God.
 - Get others involved.
 - See God's heart for the king.
 - Be credible evidence of God's greatness, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Action Item: What high-risk situation do you face?

Application:

- We are the readers; we are the ones facing high-risk situations, and we CAN raise our shield of faith.
- For the readers WHO is in CONTROL?
- For the readers WHO is worthy of your FAITH?
- For the readers WHO is leading me?

Challenge:

- Are you committed?
- Who do you find your identity with? His identity in Yahweh is WHY he could do what no one else did.
- Will you be led of the Holy Spirit to stand WITH GOD in whatever you face? So you can say, "We will..."
