• Are you listening to OTHERS?

2. Take note of our SPEAKING.

• Think before you speak.

"Those who control their tongue will have a long life; opening your mouth can ruin everything." Proverbs 13:3 NLT Ask yourself before you speak:

- Do I need to say this?
- Is what I want to say going to help or hurt?
- What's my motive for saying this?

Always speak *redemptively*. Speak with grace and peace.

3. Take note of our ANGER.

"Because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires." James 1:20 NLT

Let's Get Off the Escalator!

When things get heated, when you feel yourself getting heated, commit to never escalate the situation.

How...

- You don't raise your voice.
- Finish the conversation by calmly listening.
- You speak redemptively.
- You agree to disagree agreeably.
