Message Thread: Revelation prepares your mind to be ready.

Text: Revelation 21:1 – 4 ESV

Why The Revelation to the Church?

- Explains "WHY" things are the way they are.
- Explains "WHY" things will come to their destructive ends. Luke 19:41-44 ESV
- Explains "WHY" we want to stay close to the ONE who is the OWNER, ARCHITECT and BUILDER of the house.
- Faith Challenge: The Revelation is the story of mankind choosing the way of evil over the way of love and sonship; friendship with God.

Visions of the beast:

- The beast is the Antichrist.
- Satan is working through a person, who is leading a nation, and is influencing other nations. Revelation Chapters 13 and 17 (Daniel's visions also give us insight.)
- The beast is symbolic for the work and influence that Satan has in our world: to steal, kill and destroy at the nation state level.
- Revelation 17:11 14 ESV
 - o 7 heads
 - o 10 horns
- II Thessalonians 2:3 4 NLT
 - o The beast is also the false prophet.
 - A person embodied by Satan to prop up the Antichrist.
 - The harlot
 - A city, most likely the capital city of the Antichrist.
 - Babylon
 - Named after a city but has in mind its influence that goes way beyond its city streets.

The Battle of Armageddon:

The last Great World War that isn't fought.

Insights:

- Those who follow Jesus are to be comforted by this knowledge.
- God's justice and judgement are coming. We are simply awaiting the trial.
- God offers His grace even in the time of judgement.
- What are we, the Church, to do with this knowledge?
 - "...love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment.
 39 A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" Matthew 22:37-40 NLT
 - "Follow me..." Matthew 4:19 ESV
 - Into every room and bring the kingdom with you.
 - Choose to be bright "This will be your opportunity to bear witness. ¹⁴ Settle it therefore in your minds not to meditate beforehand how to answer..." Luke 21:13 – 14 ESV
 - A people who walk with God in their generation.
