DIGGING DEEPER / TAKING IT HOME



Acts 2:42-47(NLT)

- 42 All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer.
- 43 A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. 44 And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. 45 They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. 46 They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity— 47 all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.
- 4) What did the early church do together in the beginning?
- 5) These 4 things are ways the early church grew deeper and had greater influence on the world around them. This influence took time, but they were committed to the process. Last week Pastor Craig shared our discipleship model and how we as a church train up our people. What are the 4 components we use? How are these similar to what the early church was doing?

In thinking about taking bold measures with our generation, many times we can get the cart before the horse. We tend to think about all the problems the world faces and how some voices are louder than others. We can easily become discouraged by some of the social issues we face on a regular basis. This is similar to the early church. The culture of their time was a mess, and there was a lot going on that was wrong. They did not have an easier road; it was just different due to the pace of life and differences in technology. However, they did something that changed the world.
