Wisdom:

- 1. General truths and amazing insights grounded in God's Word. (Wisdom literature in the Bible: Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Job and Song of Solomon.)
 - Proverbs 22:6, Proverbs 25:6-7, Psalms 46:10
- 2. Sound judgement, seeing clearly, accurately. Skilled at living the written Words of God practically speaking. Right application of knowledge. The best plan, selecting the best means to achieve God's heart on the matter.

Key Passage: Acts 15:1 - 29 NLT

In this critical instance of the Church, God spoke through His written Word, the Holy Spirit and WISDOM.

Let's learn from the voice of wisdom.

- We see sharp disagreement between 2 parties using the written Word of God.
- The people/Church appealed to people more mature/learned/experienced than themselves.
- They listened to each other.
- They sought God together and searched the written Word for answers and insights.

They asked the same questions we ask.

Good questions to ask in order to hear the Spirit of God:

- Which decision will allow me to live into the voice of God's written Word, not contradict it?
- What would be consistent with the character of God revealed in the written Word?
- Am I getting confirmation?
- What is my motive?
- Will this decision lead to the Spirit of God bearing fruit in me?
- What does WISDOM tell me? (Counsel of others)
- What am I now sensing the Spirit leading me to do?

Challenge:

As God comes near to you with the written Word and His Spirit, the real questions are:

- What is He saying?

His voice speaks, am I listening?

- What questions am I asking?

His voice speaks, am I listening?
