*"Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be."* **Matthew 6:21 NLT** 

"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure that a man discovered hidden in a field. In his excitement, he hid it again and sold everything he owned to get enough money to buy the field. Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant on the lookout for choice pearls. When he discovered a pearl of great value, he sold everything he owned and bought it!" Matthew 13:44 – 46 NLT

"A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart. And I tell you this, you must give an account on judgment day for every idle word you speak." **Matthew 12:35 – 36 NLT** 

**Thread:** Our words reveal what we carefully curate in the treasury of our heart.

"Now the men of Israel were pressed to exhaustion that day, because Saul had placed them under an oath, saying, 'Let a curse fall on anyone who eats before evening—before I have full revenge on my enemies..." I Samuel 14:24 NLT

## There is POWER in your words.

- Power to Impact people for the kingdom of God
- Power to define you
- Power to trap you in commitments you don't want to fulfill
- Power to bring you grief
- Power to bring you joy
- Power to choose your motive
  - $\circ$  The good and bad are both in you.
  - "Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak..." James 1:19 NLT
- Power to defuse
- Power to repent

LEVEL 1 - Your words:

- Describe you as a Christian woman/man
- Show you as basically a good, moral person
- Help you more than they hurt you

LEVEL 2 - Your words:

- Show you are someone who walks with God
- Reveal wisdom
- Are controlled and measured
- Reveal your motive is not just about yourself but others walking with God
- Reflect the mind of Christ, which are His words for whoever you are speaking with
  - "...Who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?' But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ." I Corinthians 2:16 NLT
- Are inspired by the Holy Spirit—can we pick some low hanging fruit?
  - "…love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control…"
    Galatians 5:22 – 23 NLT
- Open the door for God to give you more influence
  - "Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock." Matthew 7:24 – 25 NLT
