##### Genesis 32:28–31 (NLT)

<sup>28</sup> “Your name will no longer be Jacob,” the man told him. “From now on you will be called Israel, because you have fought with God and with men and have won.” <sup>29</sup> Then Jacob asked, “Please tell me your name.” “Why do you want to know my name?” the man replied. Then he blessed Jacob there. <sup>30</sup> Jacob named the place Peniel—for he said, “I have seen God face to face, yet my life has been spared.” <sup>31</sup> The sun was rising as Jacob left Peniel, and he was limping because of the injury to his hip.

##### Genesis 28:16–17 (NLT)

<sup>16</sup> Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, “Surely the LORD is in this place, and I wasn’t even aware of it!” <sup>17</sup> But he was also afraid and said, “What an awesome place this is! It is none other than the house of God, the very gateway to heaven!”

##### Genesis 33:1–4 (NLT)

<sup>1</sup> Then Jacob looked up and saw Esau coming with his 400 men... <sup>3</sup> Then Jacob went on ahead. As he approached his brother, he bowed to the ground seven times before him. <sup>4</sup> Then Esau ran to meet him and embraced him, threw his arms around his neck, and kissed him. And they both wept.

##### Galatians 5:22–23 (NLT)

<sup>22</sup> But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience,

kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!
