#### **Luke 9:46–48 (NLT)**

<sup>46</sup>*Then his disciples began arguing about which of them was the greatest.*

<sup>47</sup>*But Jesus knew their thoughts, so he brought a little child to his side.*

<sup>48</sup>*Then he said to them, "Anyone who welcomes a little child like this on my behalf welcomes me, and anyone who welcomes me also welcomes my Father who sent me. Whoever is the least among you is the greatest."*

#### **Matthew 6:5–6 (NLT)**

<sup>5</sup>*"When you pray, don't be like the hypocrites who love to pray publicly on street corners and in the synagogues where everyone can see them. I tell you the truth, that is all the reward they will ever get.*

<sup>6</sup>*But when you pray, go away by yourself, shut the door behind you, and pray to your Father in private. Then your Father, who sees everything, will reward you."*

**Mark 10:42–45 (NLT)**

*<sup>42</sup>So Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. <sup>43</sup>But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, <sup>44</sup>and whoever wants to be first among you must be the slave of everyone else. <sup>45</sup>For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.”*
