Matthew 28:18–20 (ESV)

¹⁸And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

- 4) What is the mission Jesus gives to every believer in this passage, and why is it impossible without the power of the Holy spirit?
- 5) It's easy to have different definitions of things. With that thought in mind what does it mean to make a disciple? What is discipleship?
- 6) How does being 'sent' change how we view everyday life?

John 14:26–27 (NLT)

²⁶"But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. ²⁷"I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid."

John 21:15–17 (NLT)

¹⁵After breakfast Jesus asked Simon Peter, “Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?”

“Yes, Lord,” Peter replied, “you know I love you.”

“Then feed my lambs,” Jesus told him.

¹⁶Jesus repeated the question: “Simon son of John, do you love me?”

“Yes, Lord,” Peter said, “you know I love you.”

“Then take care of my sheep,” Jesus said.

¹⁷A third time he asked him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?”

Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, “Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you.”

Jesus said, “Then feed my sheep.”

- 8) One of the important keys about living a life on mission is about restoration. In John we have an example of Peter being restored by Jesus from the failure that he had during the crucifixion and his denial of Jesus.
